Contest Guidelines

- 1. Participants will deliver a speech on the specified theme.

- 6. Professionalism: Adherence to formal dress code and punctuality is mandatory.

Presentation Format

- Time Limit: 7-10 minutes.
- Structure:
- o Prelude: Introduce yourself, outline the theme, and explain its relevance to the audience.
- o Core: Discuss the topic in detail, supported by statistics, real-world examples, and analysis.
- o Conclusion: Offer insights into future prospects and provide actionable recommendations.
